





Fire Extinguishers

1. If you see a fire, call for attention, get everyone out, pull fire alarm.
2. Stay calm.
3. If using a Fire Extinguisher:
 - **PULL THE PIN, AIM LOW AT BASE OF FIRE**
 - **SQUEEZE HANDLE, SWEEP SLOWLY AT BASE OF FIRE**
 - **STAY LOW TO AVOID HEAT AND SMOKE**
4. Have the fire department check to make sure the fire is out.
5. Ventilate when fire is completely out.

Learn and know the types of fire extinguishers (see below):

CLASS A water		Ordinary Combustibles: paper, cloth, wood, rubber, many plastics.
CLASS B CO ₂		Flammable Liquids: oil, grease, gasoline, some paints, solvents etc.
CLASS C dry chemical		Electrical: wiring, fuse boxes, electrical equipment etc.
CLASS D special liquid or powder		Combustible Metals: magnesium, sodium.
