Content – Desired Results
<p>Overall Expectations: A4. demonstrate an understanding of and apply the interpersonal and communication skills necessary to work in a team environment. <p>Understandings: <i>Students will understand that/Students will know/Students will be able to...</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrate respect for their classroom and school, for each other and for themselves • Identify the 4 basic rules of the classroom • Locate the main areas of the classroom and describe their different purposes, including the fire escapes and Code Lockdown gathering area.
Product – Assessment Evidence
<p>Performance Tasks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PowerPoint presentation by teacher where students write notes of classroom rules and Demonstrating Respect • Read through Conduct Agreement and get parent/guardian signature • Teacher leads tour of classroom describing purposes of each area • Teacher point out fire exits and reviews evacuation procedure. • Teacher point out space for assembling during Code Lockdown procedures.
Other Evidence

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Observations (diagnostic) of students' behaviours and reactions to classroom expectations. Eg. preparedness with binder/pen, adherence to policy regarding use of Personal Electronic Devices. • Review of rules throughout the course will be necessary to instil expectations. Questioning students will introduce formative self-assessment.
Process – Learning Plan
<p>Learning Activities:</p> <p>Day 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teacher welcomes new students, updates names in attendance binder • Teacher leads the PowerPoint note as students write Respect and Student Expectations in their own binders. • Teacher distributes handout of Conduct Agreement • Teacher leads class on a tour of the room, giving brief explanations for different classroom areas, major equipment items, where things are locked up, etc. • Teacher points out fire escape locations and where students are to meet outside of building when fire drills occur. • Teacher points out gathering place to be used during Code Lockdown procedure. <p>Day 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teacher should collect signatures on Conduct Agreements and place in file.
Accommodations for Student Success
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students with special needs may be given appropriate timelines for completion of this activity. Handouts may be distributed with text intact for students who would benefit from these.
Teacher's Notes
<p>The teacher should prepare presentation tools such as a laptop and data projector.</p>
