

Mitre Saw Safety Rules



- 1. Operate only with the instructor's permission and after you have received proper instruction.**
- 2. Remove jewelry, eliminate loose clothing and confine long hair.**
- 3. Make sure all guards are in place and operating properly.**
- 4. Always use proper eye protection.**
- 5. Be sure the power is disconnected before making angle adjustments or changing blades.**
- 6. Always hold the work firmly against the fence and table.**
- 7. Install a new table if adequate support has been cut away.**
- 8. Allow the motor to reach full speed before starting to cut.**
- 9. Make sure the saw has come to a complete stop before removing scrap or chips from the work area.**
- 10. Be sure all guards are functioning properly.**
- 11. Make sure hands are at least 6 inches away from the spinning blade at all times.**
- 12. When cutting long pieces of material, always have support either from another person or a support stand.**
